Greetings!

Would you rather be described as a butterfly or an eagle? A mouse or a lion? I would want to be described as an awe-inspiring eagle or the King of the jungle! If I am being honest, I have at times felt like a butterfly and mouse. No power, no strength. My roar was nothing more than a small squeak. The theme for POW-WOW 2025 is **Restore my Roar!** David said in Psalm 51:12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation. Why would David say this? This Psalm came after an incident that was recorded in 2 Samuel 11. David was an established King and a mighty warrior for the Lord. He was a mighty eagle, a lion in the tribe of Judah. During his lifetime, King David did what pleased the Lord, except in the case of Bathsheba and her husband Uriah.

What dirt is to the outside of the body, sin is to the inside of a person, but soap and water cannot cleanse the inside of a man. David had certainly sinned against Bathsheba and Uriah, but he had also sinned against God. For nearly a year David attempted to cover up his sins, but God will never let us sin successfully. David knew this, so he asked for more than cleansing, as important as that is; he wanted his entire being to be restored so he could once again serve the Lord. The word restore is used over 1000 times in scripture. He wanted the joy of the Lord to be restored within him, and the face of the Lord smiling upon him. David knew that his inner person-the heart- was the source of his trouble as well as the seat of his joy and blessing, and he was incapable of changing his own heart. Only God could work the miracle.

As believers we have the Holy Spirit living inside of us. However, we can lose our effectiveness for the Lord when we grieve the Spirit and can quench him when we are disobedient. David knew it wasn't enough just to confess his sin; he had to allow the Spirit of God to renew and restore him from the inside.

What do you need to allow the Holy Spirit to restore in your life? Is it unconfessed sin? Do you have fear, anxiety, or worry? Maybe there is a situation that you see no way out of? We are going to roar to the King of Heaven and petition Him to meet us at POW-WOW 2025. The singer Brandon Lake says, "Oh come on my soul, don't you get shy on me. Lift of up your song because you got a lion inside of those lungs, get up and praise the Lord." Come to POW-WOW and lift up high the name of Jesus!

# GENERAL RULES

- Boys are to be supervised at all times and are not allowed to leave your camp without their commander's permission; and only then with the buddy system implemented. No boy around or in the river without a commander.
- Do not bring radios, tape players, or any electronic games, please leave these items locked in your bus or van.
- Campfires will never be left unattended. Fires must be extinguished before leaving the campsite.
- Everyone is to be present at morning formation, council fire, or other special events. Boys or leaders are not to stay in the campsite during these special times. Campsites will be checked.
- Leave your campsite cleaner than you found it.
- Campsites must be clean before your departure. The officers of the day will inspect your campsite for cleanliness. Please clear the campgrounds quickly on Sunday.
- Tobacco products, alcohol, non-prescription, or illegal drugs are prohibited. Individuals possessing such items will be escorted from the campgrounds.
- Do not cut or chop on live trees.
- Do not climb trees.
- No Out of State Firewood
- Keep Mud Out of Pavilion and Bathrooms
- Leader to boy ratio 1 to 5 is recommended. Adult leaders must camp with their boys in separate tents.
- Fireworks or firearms are prohibited, except for FCF display and sanctioned Events.
- Sheath knives are prohibited, except as part of an FCF costume.
- No knife of any type may be traded or sold during camp.
- Your entire outpost must be present at the awards presentation to receive your award.
- No motorized recreational vehicles are allowed in camp (scooters, golf carts, side-by-side, etc.) without authorization from the Pow-Wow Coordinator.
- Disabled commanders and boys may request lodging in cabins upon registration. Disability must prevent camping with the outpost, i. e. wheelchair bound, etc.
- Vehicles are to be parked in designated areas only. Disabled commanders and boys may request parking in other areas.
- Adults need to accompany boys to First Aid Station for treatment.
- Everyone must wear lifejackets while canoeing – regardless of age. No Exceptions.

These rules are in place for everyone's safety, & so can have lots of fun during POW-WOW!

## Preparation

Leaders - please take the time to read this packet carefully. Begin making plans with your outpost. Perhaps you can start to prepare the boys' heart. We will be emphasizing the boys greatest adventure in all life is to become a child of God and to follow Jesus in all life's decisions. Christ like character formation will take place in doing so. In doing so will prepare boys and young men in those tasks God has for them to carry out. A Guy's Journey to Manhood is a great book written by our former National Commander, Doug Marsh. I encourage you to get this book and read it for yourself. Use it as a guide in helping boys and young men to recognize and except their task as children of God. Encourage each leader and boy to get this book. At the end of each chapter there are questions relating and a time for discussion with the boys. This will help prepare the soil in their life to receive His seed as the Holy Spirit gives them increase in restored vision for manhood, and servant leadership.

One important area for your boys; Saturday evening assembly is the skit time; which can earn your outpost an additional five points towards the Grand Pow-Wow award. Exhibiting Patrol Spirit will earn even more points! Teach your boys that we want participation as well as a time of listening, worshipping, and praying. Teach them to respect the time when boys come forward to prayer time, for salvation and seeking to be filled with the Holy Spirit. Before dismissal do not leave to early or allow others to leave or joke around, but teach them to stay in an attitude of prayer and of worship. If you need to please slip out, please do so quietly. Thanks!

Marching your boys in formation with special or utility uniform with yells, cadence, and songs is a great way to gain control and motivate your boys and other outposts. In fact, you can earn points toward the Grand POW-WOW award, and Patrol Spirit award.
